## How to participate:

1. **Pray** and ask God to guide you as you study.
2. **Read** the passage several times (I also find it really helpful to make an outline of the passage, but I'm a study geek, so no pressure!).
3. **Journal!** There are countless ways to Bible Journal and there are zero rules. You can journal in your Bible, in a Bible Journal or in a spiral. Whatever works for you is great. Some people summarize what the passage says, others use the SOAP method, and others just go with whatever feels right that day. Some people are very talented artists, while others (like ME) are not, so don't put pressure on yourself to make your journaling like anyone else's. It is 100% up to you! I have a free download of the journaling format I use available on my website and I also have the journals for sale in my Etsy shop. But you do not need to buy anything to participate! A plain old spiral notebook works great. I will also post some questions / prompts on the website, but they are completely optional.
4. **Visit** Facebook or Instagram on Wednesday mornings. I will post a brief summary and some comments.
5. **Post!** Head over to [facebook.com/FarmGirlJournals](https://facebook.com/FarmGirlJournals). In the comments of my post, post a picture of your journaling and share what God has revealed to you as you studied. The BEST part of studying God's word together is learning from each other, so please be brave and share!
